MEASUREMENT OF

- "....race and Hispanic origin ... are two separate and distinct concepts.
- These standards generally reflect a social definition of race and ethnicity recognized in this country, and they do not conform to any biological, anthropological, or genetic criteria..."

HISPANIC & RACE

There are two minimum categories for data on ethnicity: "Hispanic or Latino" and "Not Hispanic or Latino." The concept of race reflects selfidentification by people according to the race or races with which they most closely identify. <u>Persons who report themselves as Hispanic can</u> <u>be of any race.</u>

- Most Non-Hispanic responses are reassigned to a specific race.

Percent in Poverty






Percent in Poverty










Education




Percent Less than High School




