- Childhood Distress Data for Six North Texas Counties
  - Dallas, Collin, Denton, Fannin, Grayson, Cooke
- Sponsored and Published by Children's Hospital,
  Dallas, with Data Compilation by UT-Dallas
- Several Issues for Northern Three Counties
  - Variable Selection
  - Frequency/Percentage Tables Only
  - Recommendations, But no Plans to Address Issues

# Why "Kids Matter – Texoma" Project

- To Address Stated Issues
  - Additional/Appropriate Variables
  - Statistical Analysis
- Increase Awareness of Childhood Distress Issues in Each County and the Region – Effect Policy
- To Facilitate Strategic Plan/Action Plan to Address One Specific Issue/Problem for Each County

# "Kids Matter – Texoma" Project Steps

- Step 1 Recruit Steering Committee for Each County and for the Texoma Region
  - ✓ Subject Matter Experts, As Well as People "In The Fray" Already
  - ✓ Determined Data Needed for Project
- Step 2 Data Collection by TCOG Staff and Austin College Interns, Directed by Michael Schmitz
  - ✓ Results "Data Book" for Region and Each County

# "Kids Matter – Texoma" Project Steps

- Step 3 TCOG Facilitated Regional Forum with Steering Committee from Each County, Plus Others
  - ✓ Goal Data Informed Consensus on Two or Three Most Critical Issues for Region in Areas of Health, Safety, Education, and Economic Security
  - ✓ Modified Charrette Exercise
- Step 4 County Steering Committee Meetings and Public Forums
  - ✓ Results Early Childhood Education Consensus in all Three Counties




