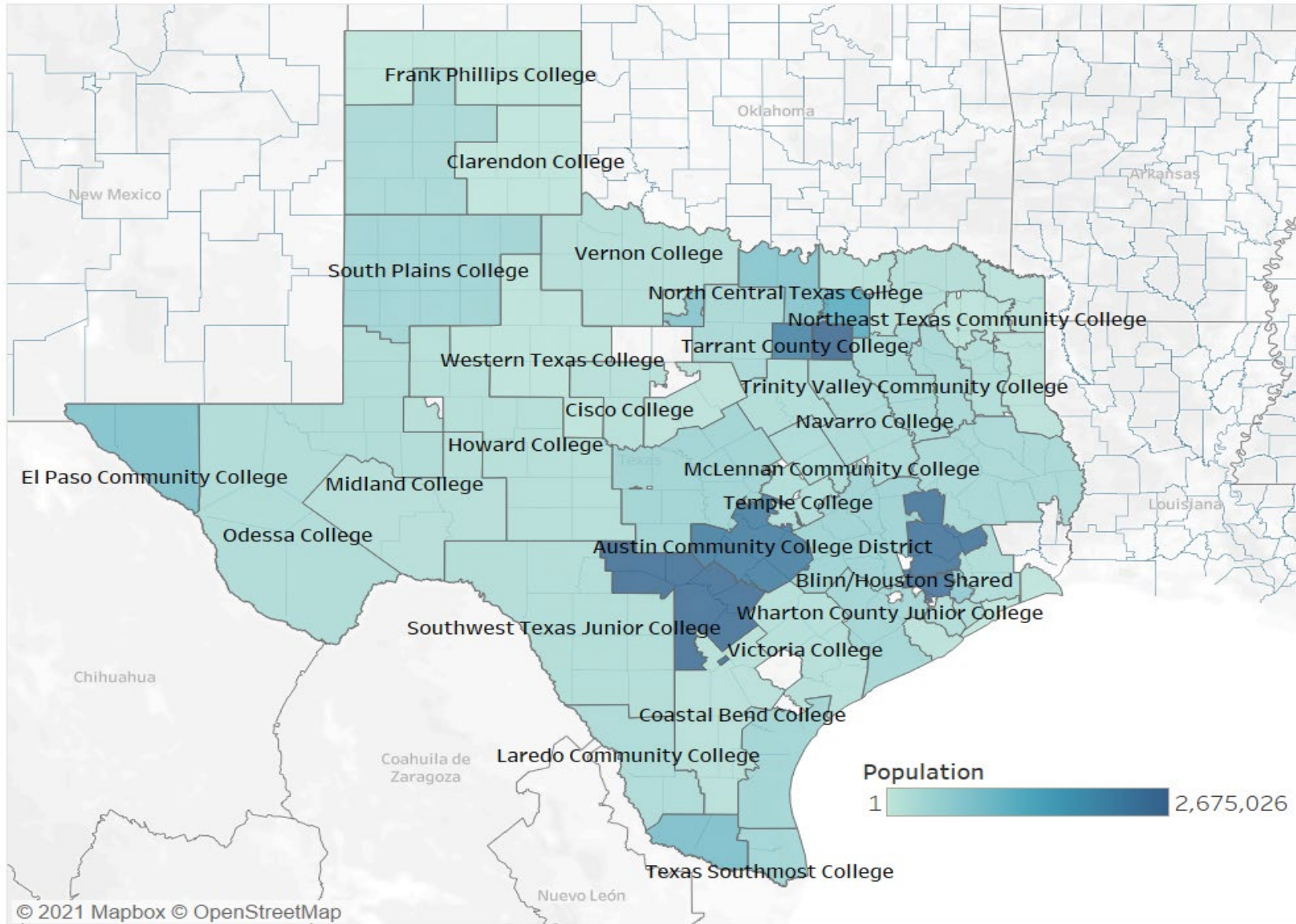


Highlights on Texas' Demographic Trends from the 2020 Census

- With **3,999,944** added population between 2010 and 2020, Texas ranked **1st** in numeric growth among all the states and was the only state that gained **two congressional seats**;
- Texas' growth rate of **15.9%** more than doubled the growth rate of the nation (7.4%);
- Over 95% of the state's growth were attributed to the **increase of persons of color**;
- The fastest growing areas in Texas are the suburban ring counties, the counties along the I-35 corridor and the "golden triangle" counties.
- 143 of the 254 counties in Texas have lost population between 2010 to 2020.



Estimated Population by Community College Service Area, 2020





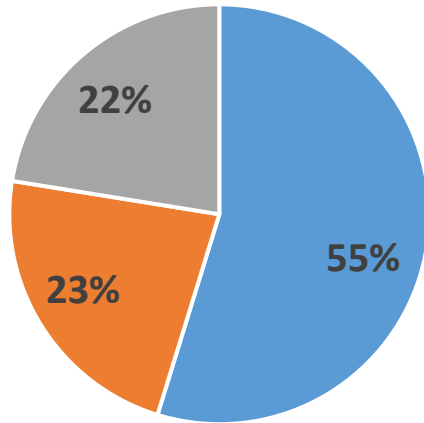
Updates from the Census Bureau's V2021 National and State Population Estimates

- Since April 1, 2020, the nation's population increased from 331,449,281 to 331,893,745, a gain of 444,464, or 0.13%, the slowest rate since the nation's founding ;
- With a population of 29,527,941 in 2021, Texas had the largest numeric gain, increasing by 382,436 (1.3%), or 1.1% annual growth.

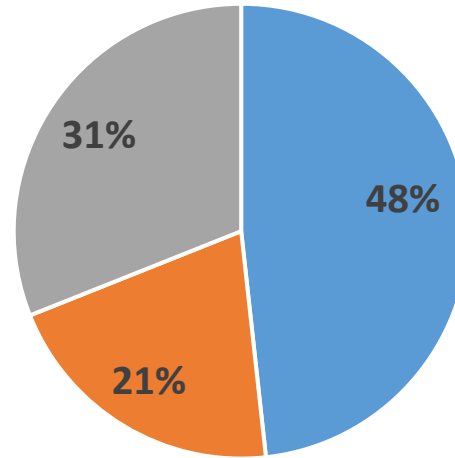


Estimated Components of Population Change for Texas, 2000-2010, 2010-2020 and 2020-2021

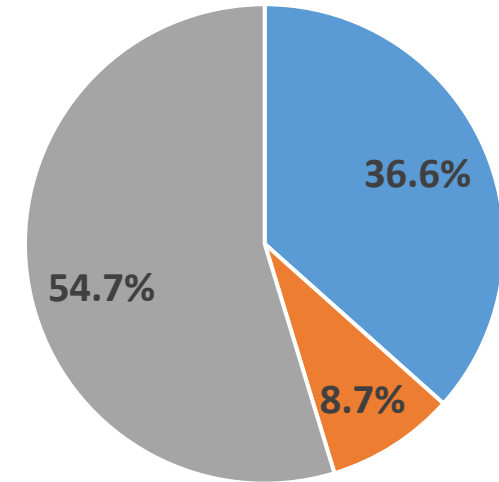

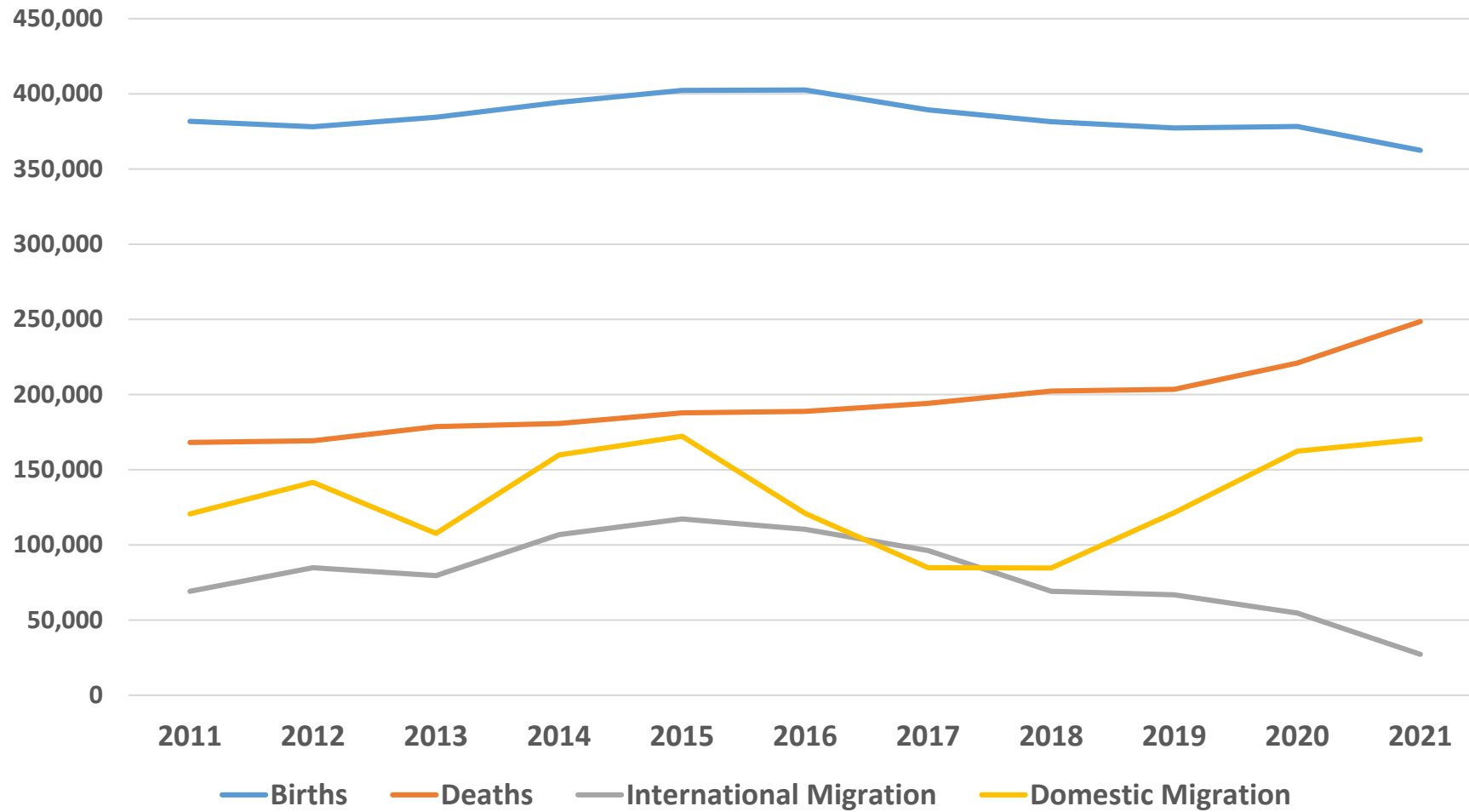

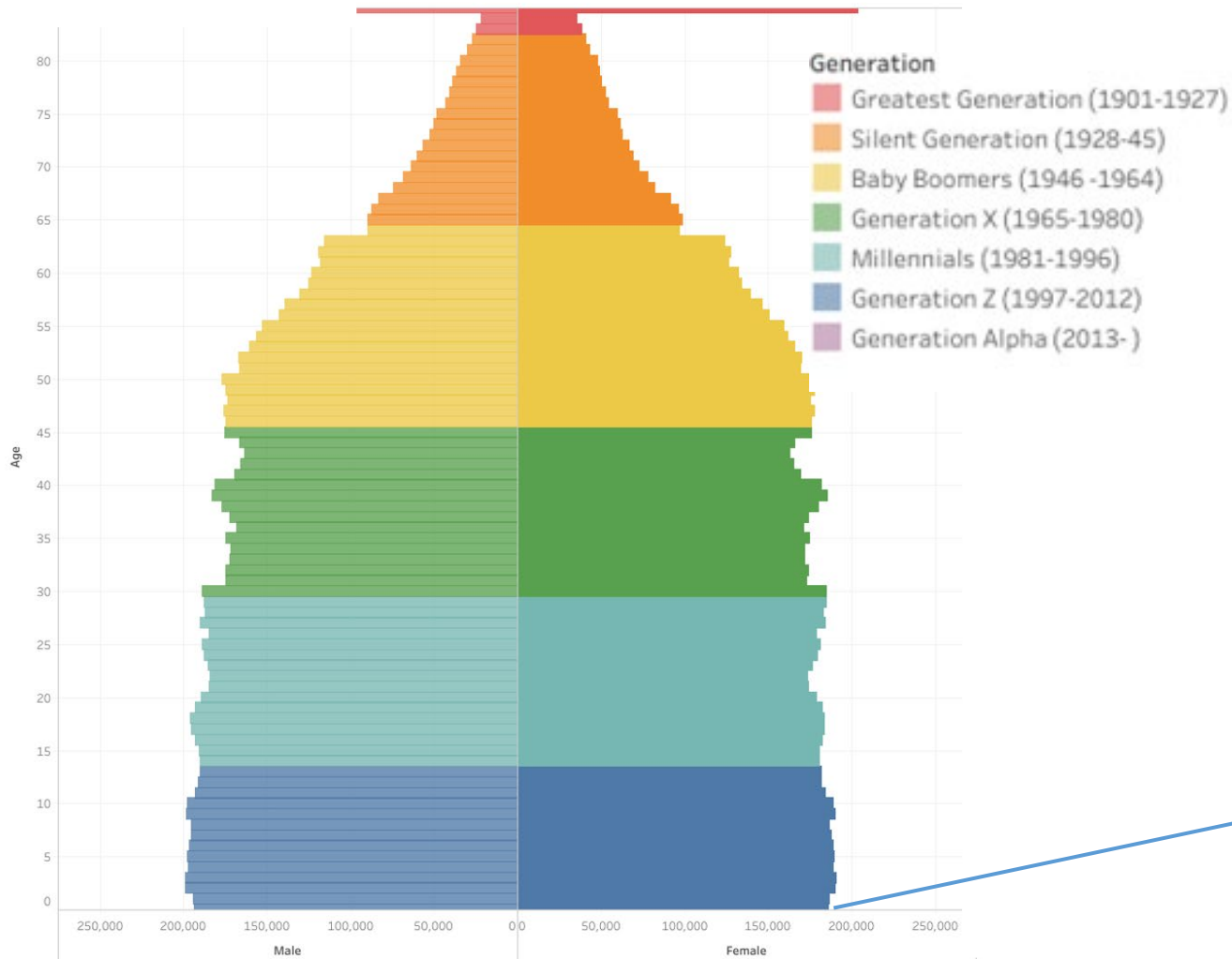
Estimated Components of Population Change 2011-2021



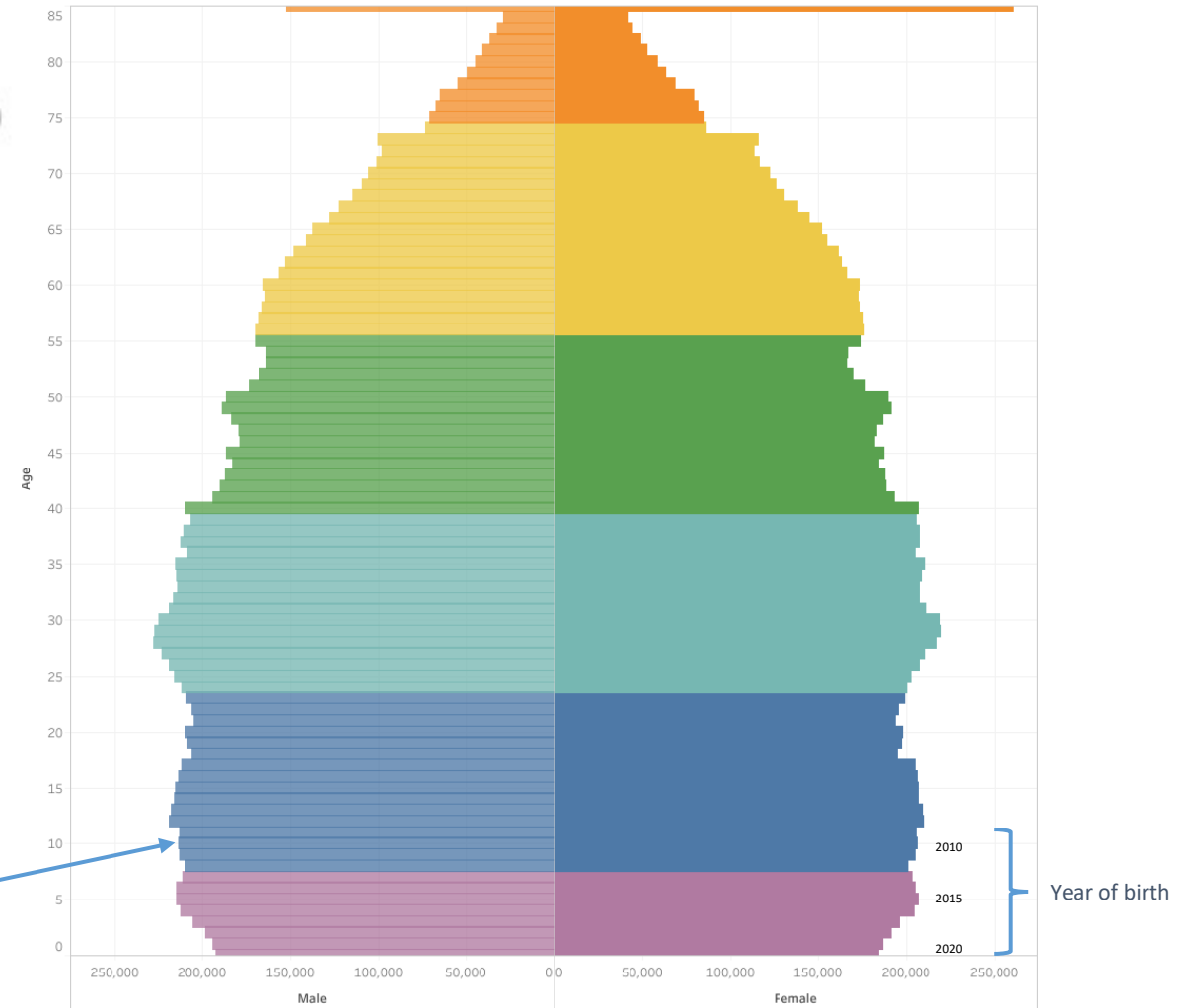


Generational Population Pyramids, Texas, 2010 and 2020

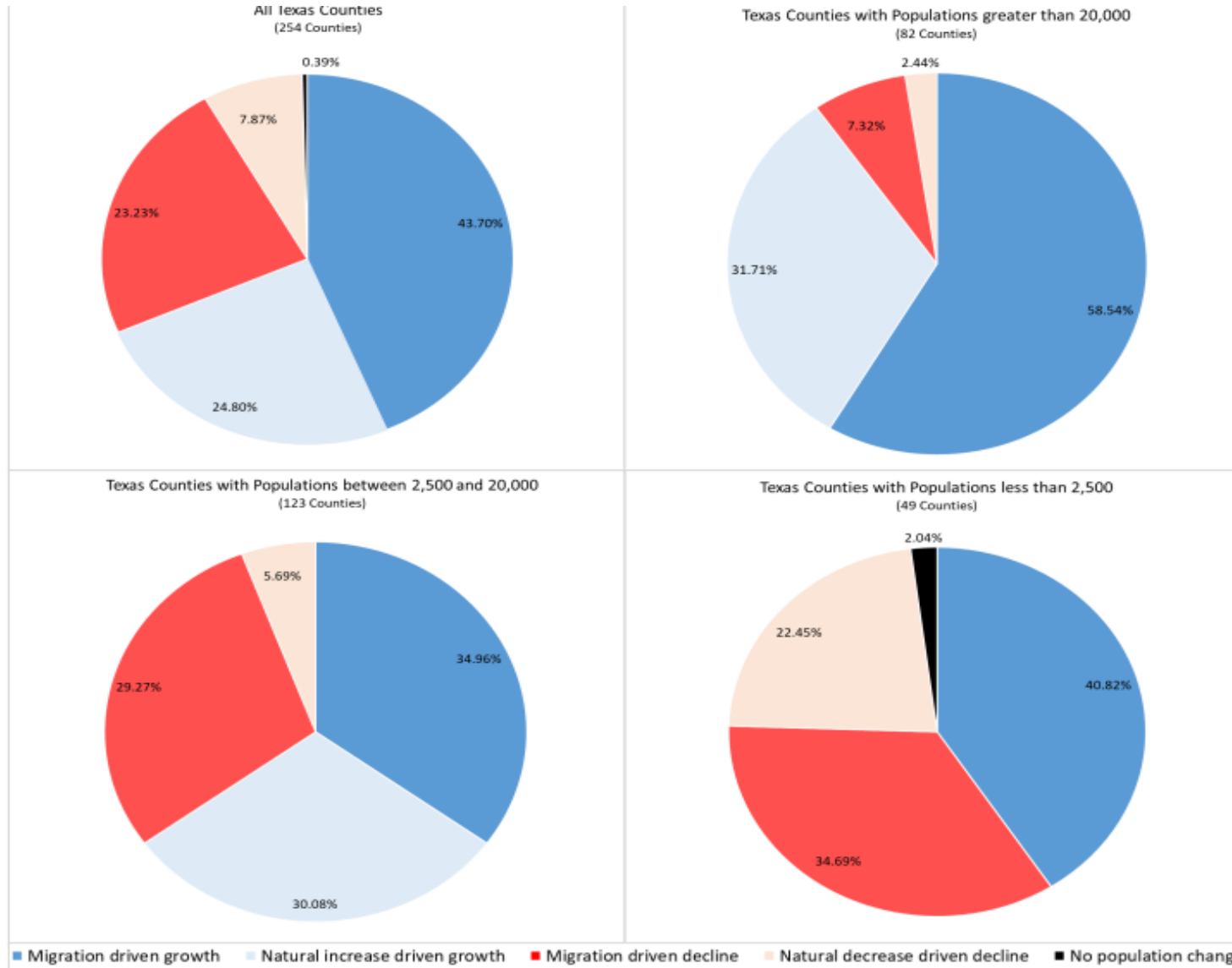

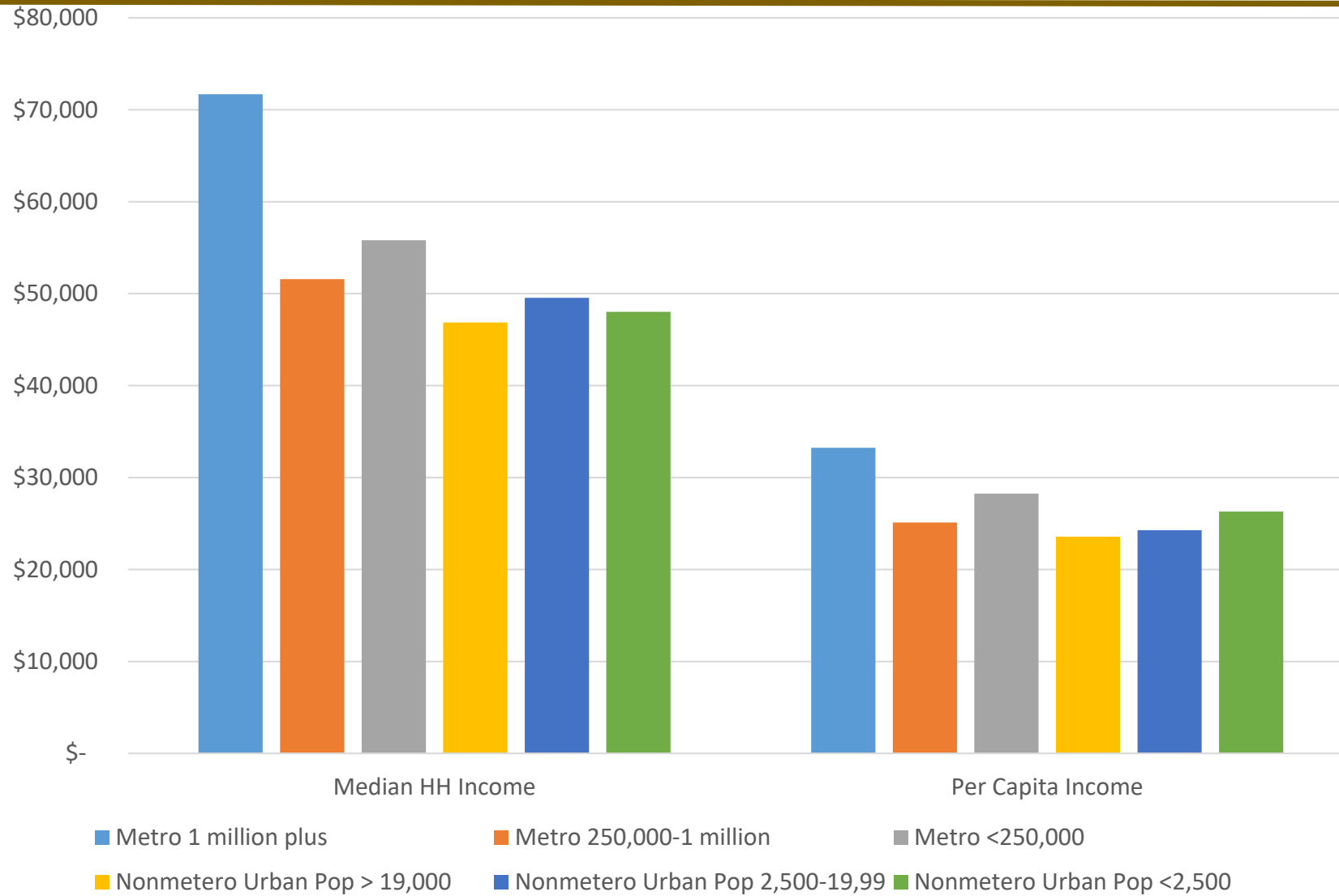


Average Characteristics of Counties by Rural/Urban Status, 2015-2019



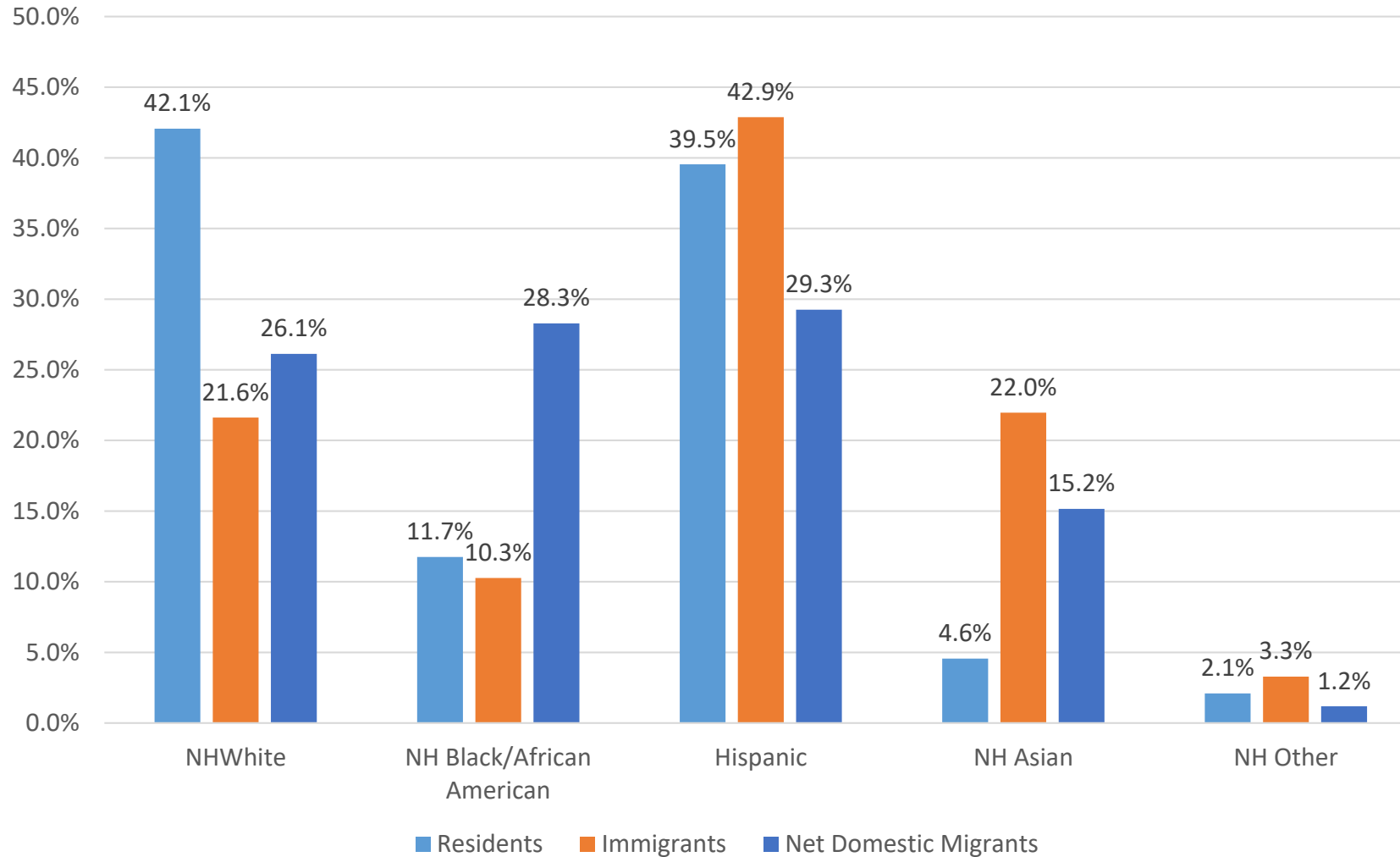


Average Median HH Income and Per Capita Income for Counties by Rural/Urban Status, 2015-2019



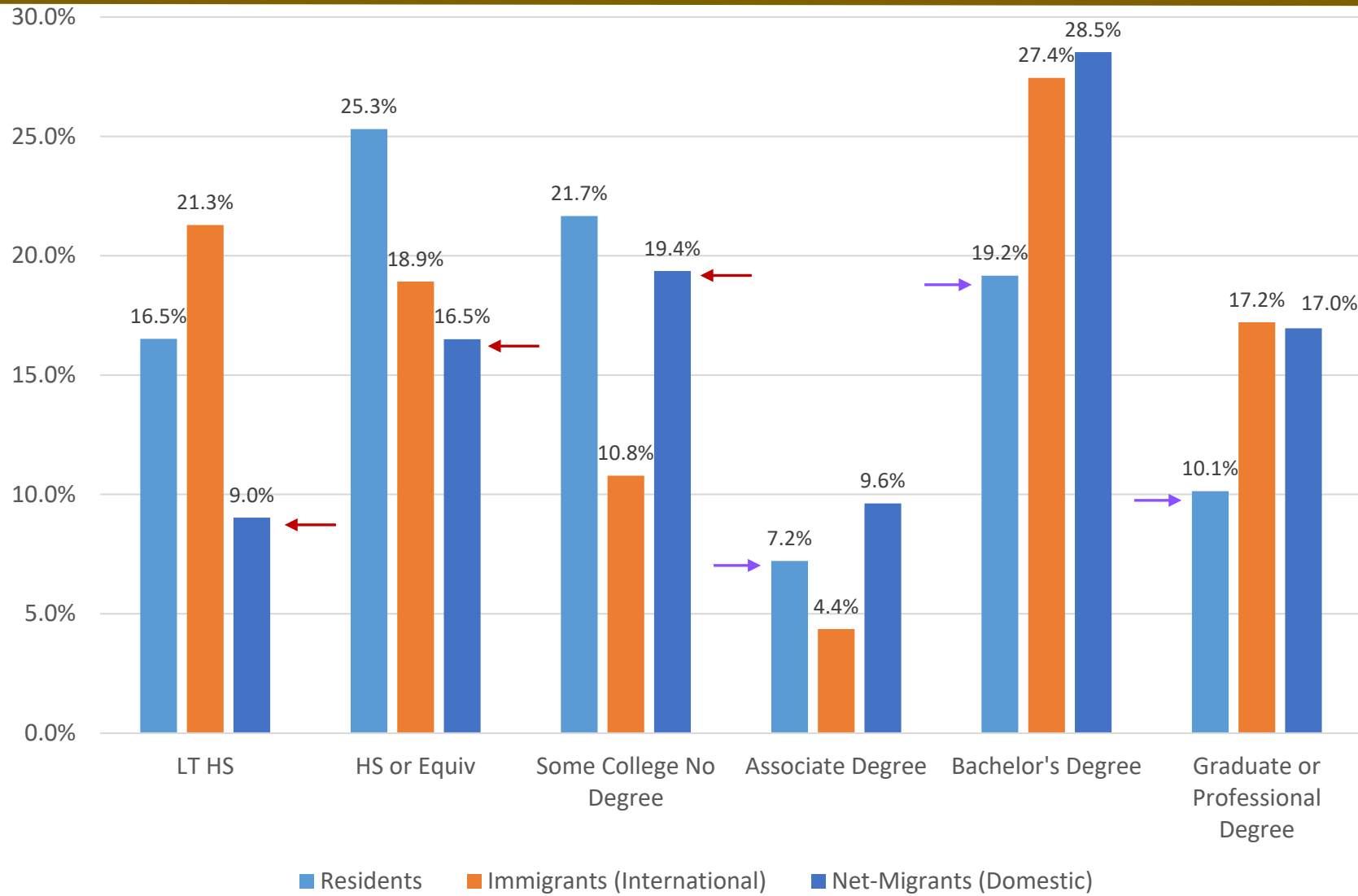

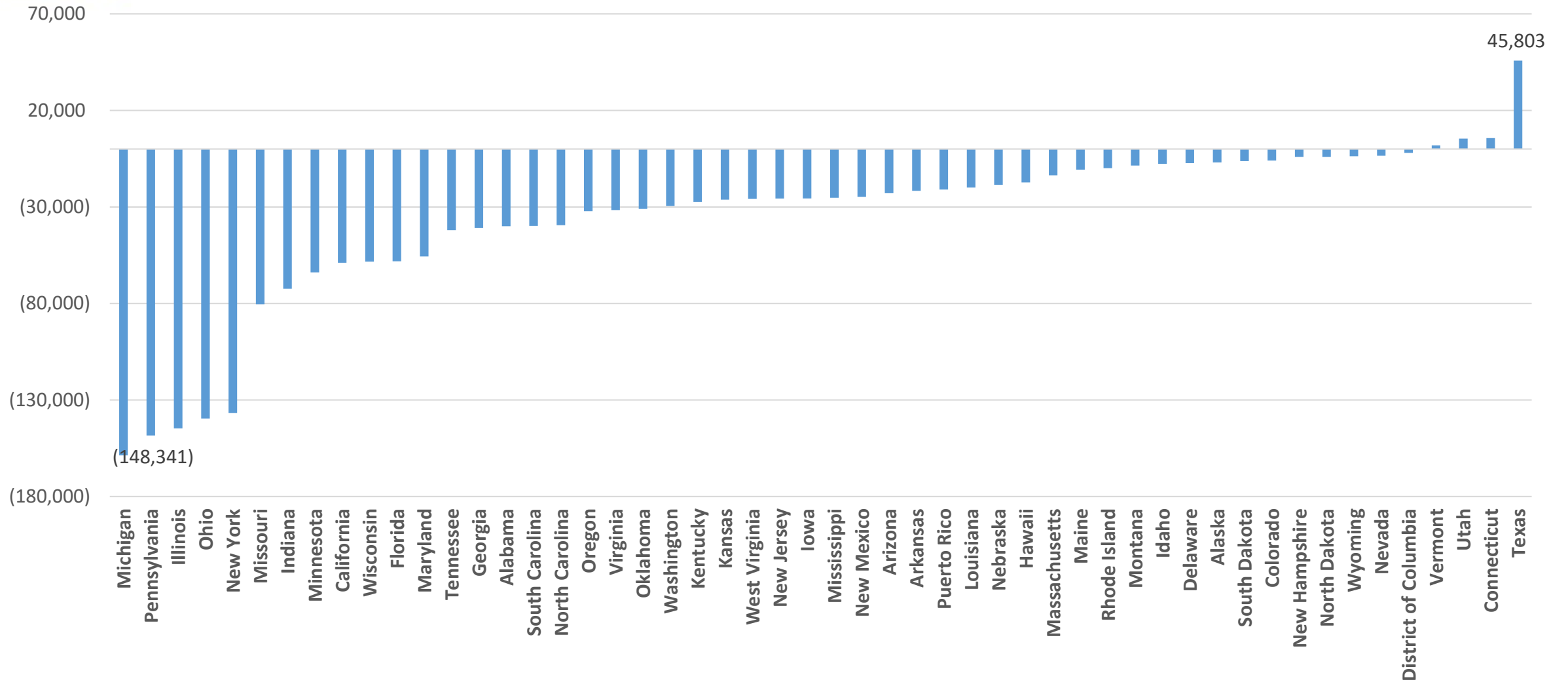

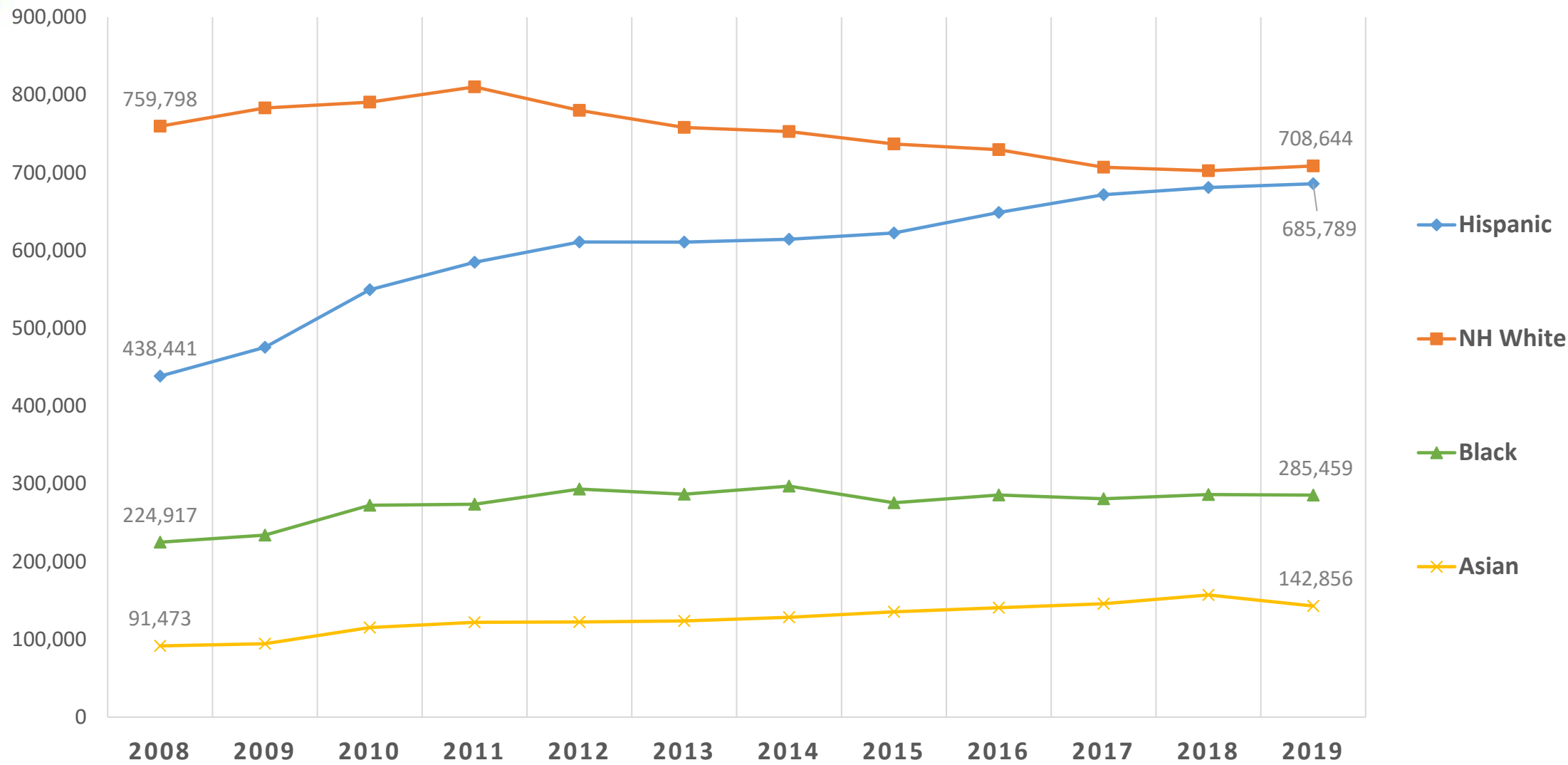
Change in Undergraduate College Enrollment by State, 2010 to 2019

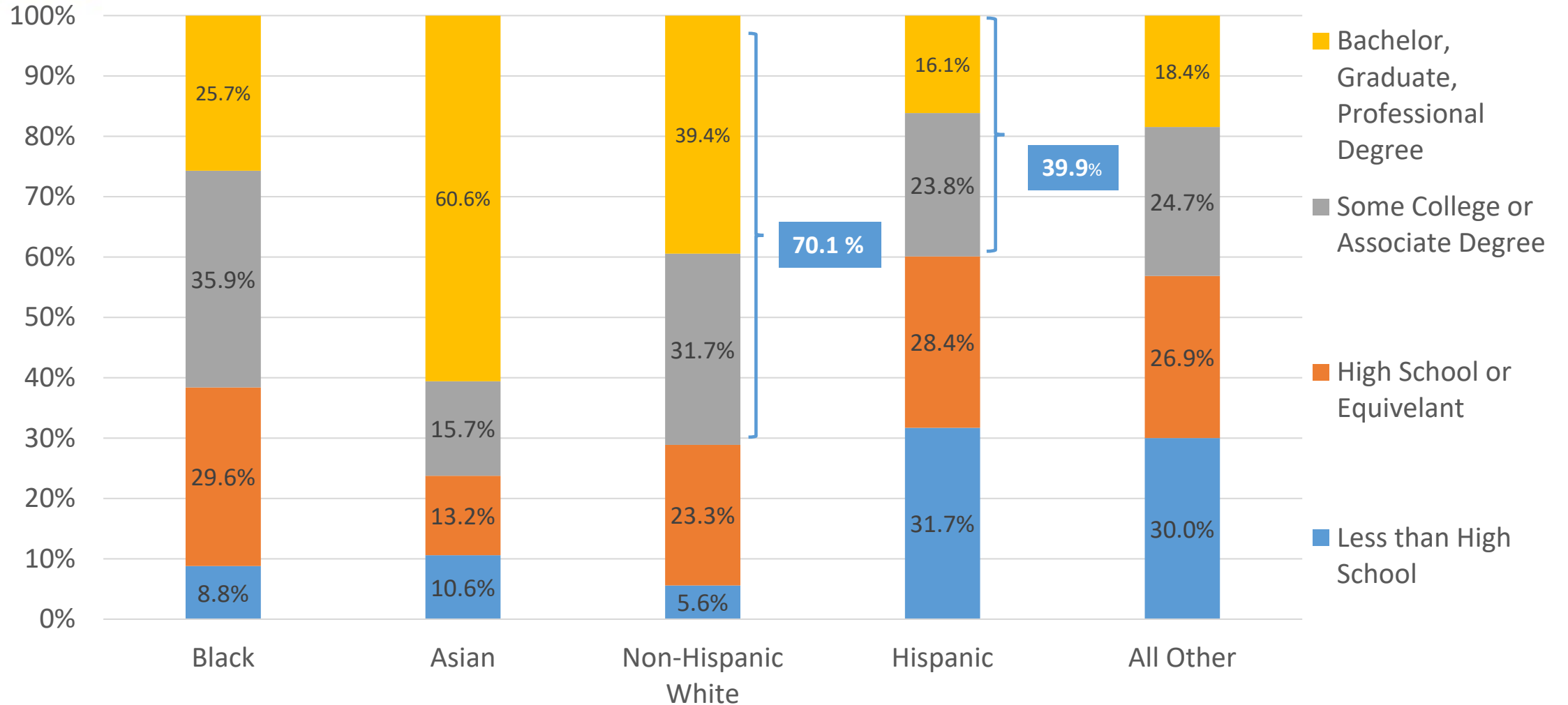
College and Graduate Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity, Texas, 2008-2019

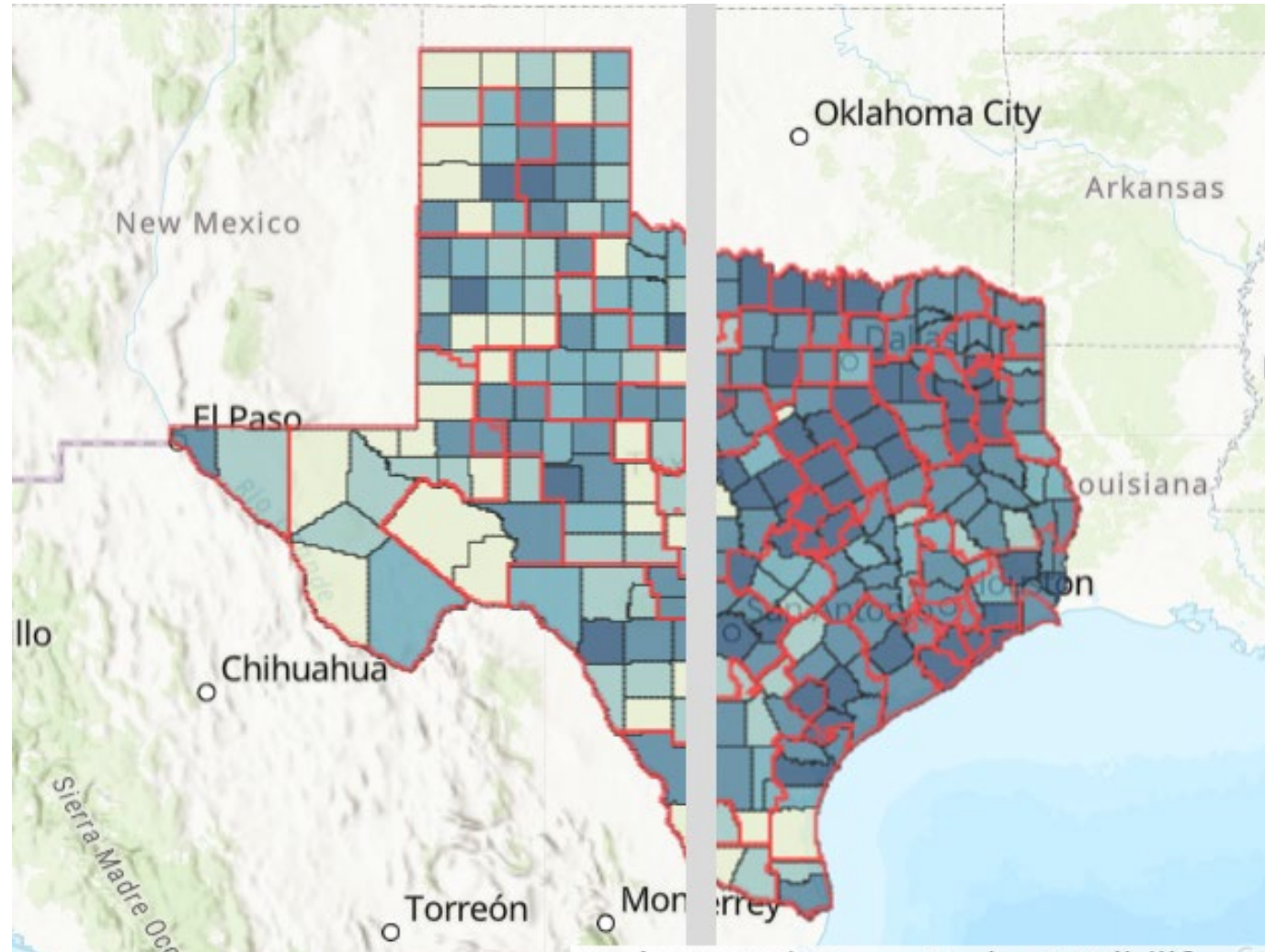
Educational Attainment of Persons Age 25 Years and Older by Race/Ethnicity, Texas, 2019
