Percent increase of Asian American population from 2011 to 2019, more than double the growth rate of the total population in the same period.

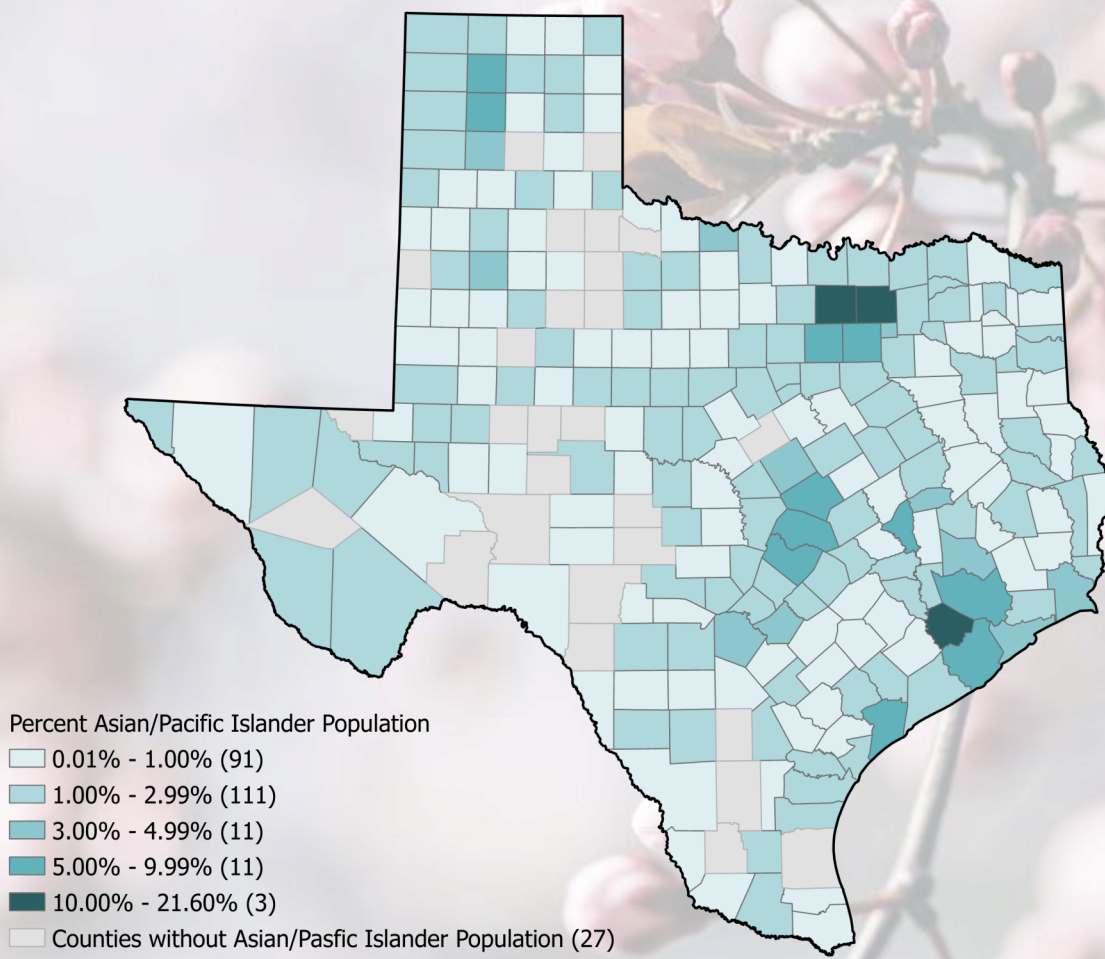

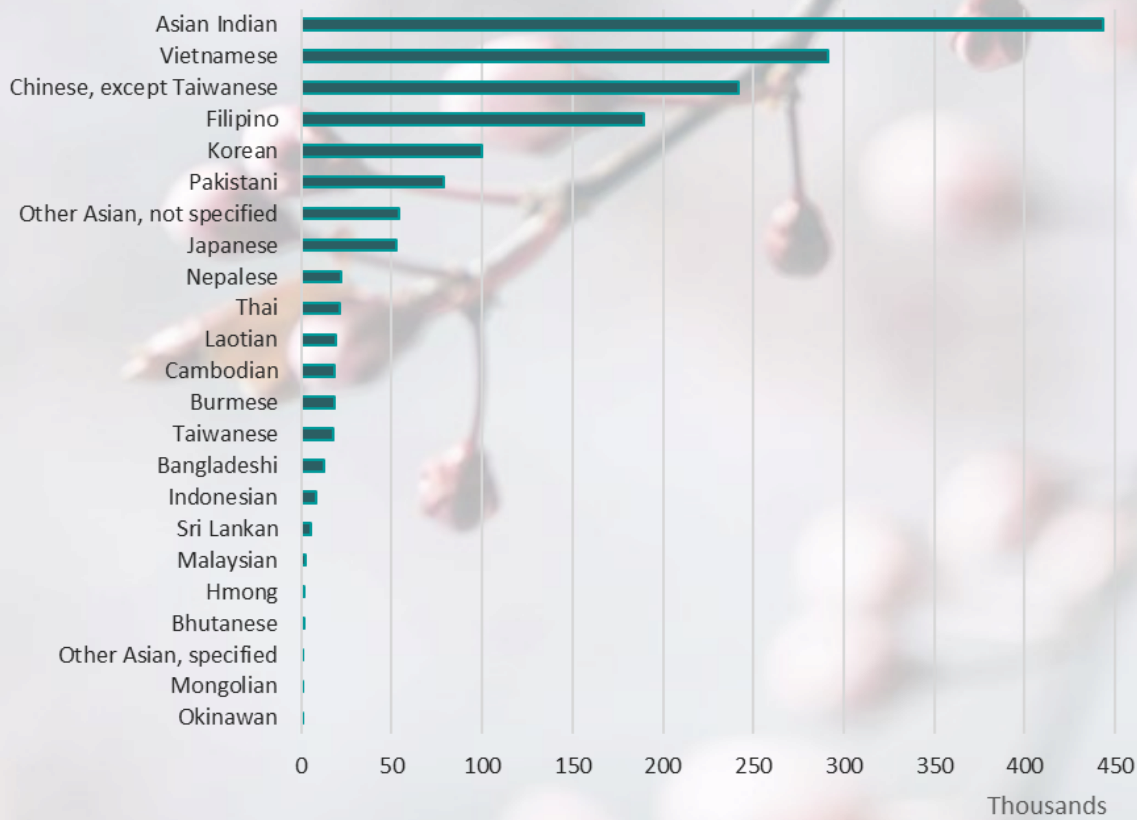
Diverse
