The Texas Economic Development & Tourism Office (EDT) promotes the state of Texas as a leading global business location and premier travel destination.




U.S. Ports of Entry in Texas

35 FTZs allow the flow of goods without formal customs entry, import quotas or most other restrictions.




International Trade & FDI

Texas leads the nation in jobs supported by exports at more than 1 million jobs.




For the 11th consecutive year in 2023, Texas led the nation in high-tech exports. Texas' t include China, s

Aerospace, Aviation & Defense



The aerospace, aviation and defense sector directly employs nearly 145,000 Texans.



Texas ranks #3 in the nation for aerospace products & parts exports valued at approximately \$10 billion.



18 of the 20 largest aerospace companies have operations in the state.



After a nationwide search, Texas was selected for the U.S. Army's Futures Command headquarters.



Texas' 15 active military installations have more than \$100 billion impact on the state economy.



Texas is home to more than 1,900+ aerospace, aviation & defense related establishments.

Biotechnology & Life Sciences



Texas is home to more than 105,000 workers in life science related fields.



More than 33,000+ clinical trials are currently underway (#2 nationally).



Texas is home to more than 6,000 life science research firms.

Annual research & development expenditures total over \$6.6 billion.










Texas ranks #2 in the nation for Computer and Mathematical Occupations.


