



Texas Senate District 1, PLANS172

Counties included wholly or partially in Senate District 1: Bowie, Camp, Cass, Franklin, Gregg, Harrison, Lamar, Marion, Morris, Panola, Red River, Rusk, Smith, Titus, Upshur, and Wood.

Between 2010 and 2020, most counties in Senate District 1 are projected to grow in population size, with Smith and Gregg counties driving much of this growth. The following counties are projected to decrease in population size: Cass, Marion, Morris, Red River, and Rusk counties. During this time period, the non-Hispanic (NH) White population is projected to decrease in size in most counties, with the exception of Camp, Smith, Upshur, and Wood counties. The NH Black population is projected to increase in all counties, except for Cass, Lamar, Morris, and Rusk counties. The Hispanic, NH Asian, and NH Other population groups are projected to increase in size in all counties.
