



Texas Senate District 29, PLANS172

Counties included wholly or partially in Senate District 29: Culberson, El Paso, Hudspeth, Jeff Davis, and Presidio.

Between 2010 and 2020, all counties in Senate District 29 are projected to experience population decline, with the exception of El Paso County, which is projected to grow by over 75,000. During this time, the non-Hispanic (NH) Black, NH Asian, and NH Other population groups are projected to increase in population size in those areas where there is already a presence of these race groups. The NH White population is projected to increase in population size in El Paso County, grow modestly in Culberson and Hudspeth, and decline in population size in Jeff Davis and Presidio counties. The Hispanic population is projected to drive population growth in El Paso County, grow modestly in Jeff Davis, and experience population decline in Culberson, Hudspeth, and Presidio counties.
