



### Texas Senate District 3, PLANS172

Counties included wholly or partially in Senate District 3: Anderson, Angelina, Cherokee, Hardin, Henderson, Houston, Jasper, Liberty, Montgomery, Nacogdoches, Newton, Orange, Polk, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Shelby, Trinity, and Tyler.

Between 2010 and 2020, approximately half of the counties in Senate District 3 are projected to grow in population size, with Montgomery County driving much of this growth. The following counties are projected to decrease in population size: Anderson, Houston, Jasper, Nacogdoches, Newton, Sabine, San Augustine, Trinity, and Tyler. Population decline in Senate District 3 will be driven mostly by declines in the non-Hispanic (NH) White population, followed by declines in the NH Black population. The Hispanic, NH Asian, and NH Other population groups are projected to increase in population size in all counties.
