Counties included wholly or partially in Senate District 31: Andrews, Armstrong, Bailey, Briscoe, Carson, Castro, Cochran, Collingsworth, Dallam, Deaf Smith, Donley, Ector, Gaines, Glasscock, Gray, Hall, Hansford, Hartley, Hemphill, Howard, Hutchinson, Lipscomb, Loving, Martin, Midland, Moore, Ochiltree, Oldham, Parmer, Potter, Randall, Roberts, Sherman, Swisher, Wheeler, Winkler, and Yoakum.

Between 2010 and 2020, most counties in Senate District 31 are projected to increase in population size. The following counties are projected to see population declines: Briscoe, Carson, Castro, Deaf Smith, Donley, Hall, Hutchinson, Moore, Parmer, and Swisher. During this time, the non-Hispanic (NH) White population is projected to decrease in population size in most counties, with significant losses in Potter, Hutchinson, Deaf Smith, and Moore counties. The Hispanic, NH Black, NH Asian, and NH Other population groups are projected to continue to grow in those areas where there is already a presence of these race groups, with some exceptions. The NH Black population is projected to decline in Potter and Briscoe counties, and the Hispanic population is projected to decline in Castro and Parmer counties.
