

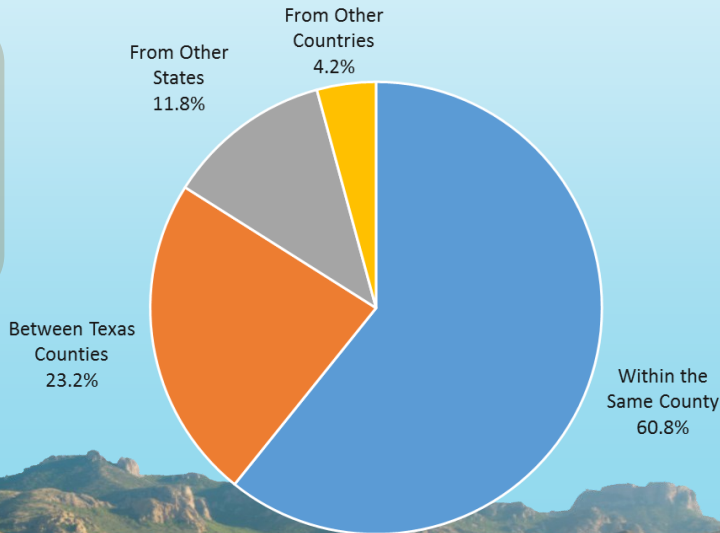
TEXAS MOBILITY

Part of our Domestic Migration report series. To learn more about the mobility patterns of Texans, go to our brief *Texas Mobility*.

The stream of people moving to Texas has received much attention. Migration has added around a quarter of a million new Texans a year, and this has raised concerns about whether the state can accommodate this kind of growth. However, with one million people moving between Texas counties, far more migration begins and ends within the state.

Annual Percentage of Total Moves by Mobility Type in Texas, 2009-2013

- ⇒ **4.3 million** Texans lived in a different residence a year ago.
- ⇒ **16%** of these movers originated outside of Texas.
- ⇒ The other **84%** originated within Texas.
- ⇒ **One million** of these moved from one Texas county to another.
